The 20th Anniversary of the New Smyrna Beach Jazz Festival takes place May 20th thru 22nd, 2022. The event opens with a free concert featuring the 10-piece US Navy Band Southeast playing New Orleans music. Location: Marine Discovery Center Amphitheatre from 6 to 7:45 pm.

This year's line-up will feature many favorite performers who have played the festival over the years. From Brevard, the list includes: **Sybil Gage** and her Merry Band of Catahoulas; **Ron Teixeira Trio** featuring **Jacqueline Jones**; and for a festival first, **Tony Wynn** and **Cameron Brown** Duo. Also appearing will be The Joshua Bowlus Trio and Linda Cole; Greg Parnell Septet and their tribute to Herb Alpert and the Tijuana Brass. Rich Walker from Portland, OR will have his Septet with him; Kid Dutch and his New Orleans Music TM; Orlando Sanchez; Ella and The Bossa Beat featuring Dan Jordan; smooth jazz artists Thom Chambers and Robert Harris and many more. More outdoor shows have been added to venues along Flagler Avenue, Canal Street, Third Avenue, South Atlantic and Riverside Drive.

#### **The Happy Together 2022 Tour**

2022 will mark the 13th year of the highly successful, hit-filled summer package, The "Happy Together" Tour. The touring sensation that has criss-crossed the nation delighting audiences for a over a decade returns this summer with a show full of chart-topping hits from the '60s and '70s. The Tour is again joined by The Turtles, who also act as musical hosts, along with The Association, The Buckinghams, The Classics IV, The Vogues and The Cowsills.

The Turtles are best known for their harmony-heavy California pop sound. With such hits as "Elenore," "She'd Rather Be With Me," "It Ain't Me Babe," "You Showed Me" and the title of the tour, "Happy Together," the band ruled the airwaves in the late '60s. Ron Dante joins the line-up to delight with his own mega-hits, "Sugar Sugar" and "Tracy."

Also returning to the tour for 2022 are **The Association**, who enjoyed massive radio success in the '60s with such #1 hits as "Cherish," "Windy," "Never My Love" and "Along Comes Mary". This iconic vocal group was a staple on the radio airways in the 1960s.

The Buckinghams were formed in 1966, and went on to become one of the top selling acts of late 1960's, including their #1 hit "Kind of a Drag," and other hits "Don't You Care," "Mercy, Mercy, Mercy" and "Hey Baby, They're Playing Our Song." With 3 chart hits at one time on 2 labels in 1967, *Billboard Magazine* named them "The Most Listened to Band in America."



Take A Break From Awake

### DREAMLAND ADVENTURES

The definition of 'Dreamland' in Webster's dictionary is "an unreal delightful country existing only in imagination or in dreams." One could argue that the last few years were more bizarre than anyone's imagination could have predicted. With the haze lifting, it's time to experience Dreamland through the eyes of Derek Gores.

We last saw our resident world renowned artist cultivating young minds at his inaugural 'Create Your World' art camp last summer. Prior to that, the reactivated *Robot Love* multi week exhibition was one of the first live Brevard events post lockdown. Now in 2022, Gores and his entourage of artist misfits introduce us to the next logical step of life after a pandemic: mini golf.

The idea isn't that far fetched. Located in the now defunct Foosaner Art Museum in the Eau Gallie Arts District, the space is completely transformed into the concept of *Dreamland*. "I was in England and came across this idea of

doing a pop up mini golf course in an old retail spot," Gores explains during a private tour. "We get together on Tuesdays and I posed the question 'What does everyone think of mini golf?"

The new owner of the property, Developer Larry Jarnes, had asked Gores if something or someone could use the space while he continued his plan to build a hotel/parking garage later on this year. Gores abided. "Dreamland is our artistic twist on putt putt. It's the original STEAM activity; playground meets MacGyver. 90 percent recycled materials, 100 percent fun for all ages," says Jarnes, "Eau Gallie is really beginning to pop with so many exciting projects on the way. Art is the secret ingredient here to make it happen. I knew Derek and his friends could keep the energy up until we start building the hotel."

It was there at the Tuesday night gatherings that artist/engineer Steve Monroe, artist/camp teacher Sarah Peck and others started to create the concept of Dreamland. For starters, Gores assigned the task of individuals creating each hole with a vision, eventually tying into the dream concept. "The initial hole; complete with fake Christmas trees leading into a mirrored bedroom splits the course into 2 options; dream and seemingly darker dreams. Family friendly, each course offers both visual and skill level choices.

The golf courses themselves, made up of Maguyver like simplicity, are deeply impressive. "I knew it would be a lot of work, but didn't realize it would become my life," remarks Monroe, who first met Gores during the construction of last year's Robot Love. "It's been pretty wild. I've always been into vintage and cheesy mini golf attractions since a little kid. That and roadside attractions. Making a walk thru volcano and a giant moai have always been on my bucket list." The actual start of installation to opening the doors to the public were just over 2 weeks in March. "I was working on the last hole several hours into opening night. At that point I think I was just exhausted, but knew we still had several days of tweaking and opening activities," Monroe recalls.

Fans of our art scene will instantly recognize an artist's niche. Jamie Meagher's Lego infused design is a hit with all ages. Frequent Gores collaborator Peck made 3 designs; "Inner Child Galaxy" (solar system), "The Dream Weavers" (spiderweb in the blacklight room), and "Ouija Plinko" (in the first room, plinko board after a ramp and the black paint melting from the ceiling).

Artist Noah Cook is also highly represented. His 3D city art is displayed prominently on the back wall. "It's designed to give a 'Godzilla' like feel to it as the golfers play through," explains Gores. Cook had interned with Gores a few years ago at his gallery "hanging art, setting up shows and learning the business." After earning his Graphic Design degree from Flagler University, he has moved back to Brevard. He painted the brightly colored logo of Dream-

land on the outside wall of the Foosaner that really sets the stage for what is inside.

Not only does the course have to be visually pleasing, but functioning to get the golfers through the course. A homage to Caddyshack is a subtle highlight for those in the know. Words alone cannot describe the complexity, constructed by mostly household items and ingenuity. You truly have to see it for yourself.

At the half way point of the courses is a music stage. Gores is very intentional in overlapping different art disciplines together, whether it was having dance represented at Robot Love or now an acoustic lounge featuring local talent. "It truly was like playing in a dream," says musician Skylar Green who recently performed at Dreamland. "From ethereal art to ethereal music, I was standing on the stage right in the middle of it all."

Just when you can wrap your head around the concept of mini golf created by our local art scene, Gores flips the script with a 'Selfie Museum'. Staged in adjoining rooms across from the courses, patrons can partake in camera ready backgrounds ranging from vintage (a 70's inspired office complete with filing cabinets and desk phone) to the very popular Noah Cook designed 3D landscape. 15 pieces in all where kids of all ages strike a pose to post or frame.

What selfie museum would be complete without the infamous 'Dumpster Fire' piece from Robot Love? Designed by artist and collaborator Cliffton Chandler, it was a big hit at a recent Miami Art show that Gores and his cohorts participated in. In fact the life-size 'dumpster' is not a metal dumpster at all. "It is made of plywood and is in fact very fragile," Monroe confides. "We were moving it from my studio to the Foosaner when the wheels literally fell off," Gores recalls. Truly a life meets art moment and fan favorite for all involved.

Dreams can be thought of as an escape. Is Dreamland an escape from life? "Definitely not an escape," Gores contends. "It's reality, bent and recombined in new ways. Dreamland let us play with physics and color like only Space Coast kids could."

At press time Dreamland is scheduled to close at the end of June. Construction on the upcoming hotel/parking garage set to be built where the Foosaner stands is late 2022. Part of the proceeds from Dreamland fund scholarships to this summer's 'Create Your World' art camp. One thing is for sure, there are more 'Dreamland' concepts brewing in the mind of Gores and willing parties are ready to partake in the adventure.

### UNIT 5

By D. Blues

It is one of those fantastic Florida spring nights. The band is setting up and people are starting to fill the venue. The band breaks into a couple of verses of ZZ Top's "Waiting for the Bus" as a soundcheck and get a resounding applause as they stop. Everyone is ready for a night of drinks, food, good times, music and more. Unit 5 is on the stage and ready to rock your night!

You can visit numerous venues in Brevard County and groove to the music of some really great musicians but would you ever think you'll get a history lesson while enjoying your favorite drink and music? If you are there to see Unit 5, the history lesson is part of the show. The band is celebrating its fifth year together and is stronger than ever playing a powerful set list of classic rock and blues songs. They change up their set lists constantly while keeping a core of audience favorites so when you see them you hear something different than you did the last time.

The band started by placing a Craigslist ad. Steve Le Clair had an idea to change up the music he was playing in another band to more of what he'd like to hear when he goes out. He remembers: "The previous band I was in had taken a break as our singer/guitar player moved out of town plus I was traveling too much for work to commit to a band at that time. We started up again with different members but we were picking a lot of the songs we had done before the break and many of these songs I wasn't wanting to continue to do. I wanted to add more blues and some heavier music from late 60's



and early 70's music so I left. I figured there would be others who might want to do the music I wanted to play so I put in an ad with the idea of finding like souls who wanted to play the music I love; that is Zeppelin, Montrose, Aerosmith, Johnny Winter, Muddy Waters, Allman Brothers and groups similar to those. I hoped that not only I could find bandmates but that once we gigged out that people would come and support us. Luck had it that my search didn't take too long. Spero Tshontikidis our singer answered my ad the same day and told me his wife played bass and they have a keyboard player also. I had a drummer already so we were set. As we worked, we were able to book more and more gigs and our fan base grew so all was moving in the right direction." The group consists of four members so let's meet Unit 5.

Spero Tshontikidis is the singer and adds percussion. His background is extensive but he's most proud of his military service having served two tours in Afghanistan as a Special Forces soldier in support of *Operation Enduring Freedom*. He's presently a school counselor which he's done for

37 years. He also owns and coaches at the Strong Life Gym in Indian Harbour Beach and is president of R.A.W. United Powerlifting Federation. Several of his students hold records in weightlifting. When not working or performing you can catch him at the beach surfing or bodyboarding. He's married to Caryn the bass player.

Caryn Tshontikidis is the bass player who gets a lot of double takes as she happens to play left-handed (!) and contributes background vocals also. She works for lawyer Kurt Panouses who is known as the Lottery Lawyer. She's from Long Island originally, and her and Spero live in Melbourne Beach now. In her spare time, she enjoys furniture painting/restoration and home design. As mentioned above, she's married to Spero the singer.

Matt Thompson is the drummer and does lead and background vocal, too. He's been playing drums in Brevard County since 1994 with various bands including Smuggler, Backlash, Page Drive, and Small Talk. For those drummers out there, he plays a Shaun Traynor Custom kit with Zildjian cymbals all around. He works as a physical therapist and is an active bee keeper

(the band is lucky that he shares his incredible honey!). You might see Matt at the beach surf fishing, biking, or golfing as well.

Steve Le Clair is on guitar and background vocals. He's retired from a corporate life of lending and lending operations and now does mostly band stuff like promotions, bookings, and show preparation along with some grandfather duties. Outside of music you can find him running, at the beach or bike trails on weekends when the band isn't playing.

As you can see, they have a pretty varied background of experiences outside of music but what they do have in common is a goal to bring the energy of the music they play to every show. Unit 5 focuses on blues-based rock mostly from the late 60's,70's and 80's but they are known to throw in some Elvis and Fats Domino on the rock side of things and numerous blues songs from the 40's and 50's. On a typical night you'll hear Stones, Beatles, Zeppelin, AC/DC, David Bowie, Black Crowes and others on the rock side and the Allman Brothers, Tab Benoit, Muddy Waters, Jimi Hendrix, Albert King, Cream, Stevie Ray Vaughn and more on the blues side. One of the band's traditions is Spero adding some historical content on the song or the artist and group. Why the history lesson? "Well part of my past life I was as a history teacher so it's not much of a stretch," Spiro chuckles, "but the songs we play all have a basis in blues so I like to share the history of when a song or album was released or who wrote and played it originally. I get a lot of positive feedback from the people who come to watch us."

Where does the Unit 5 name come from and what does it mean since they only have four members? Spero explains: "It really does not have a meaning. Early on with an upcoming gig, the band needed a name. We threw out some ideas after one of our rehearsals and Steve thought a Harris warehouse he had seen with a large luminated number looked cool. I threw out what about Unit 5?" That happened to be the unit in the warehouse that they rehearsed in. Coincidently, at the time they did have a fifth member by the name of River Grace on keyboards though. He was a senior in high school so he had that choice to make upon graduation: stay in Melbourne and play keyboards in a part-time cover band or go to MIT for college. He picked college! He still sits in with them from time to time as he is now in medical school at UF.

What are their influenses? Spero responds: "As a big fan of the rock that I grew up with, the bands that got me into music are Aerosmith, Montrose, and Led Zeppelin."

Caryn names The Beatles as "definitely my favorite who got me into loving music. George is my one!" Matt: "As a drummer I look toward percussion in music in general but Alan White of Yes definitely was my biggest influence." Steve's biggest influence for playing guitar is Jeff Beck. "He definitely is an idol of mine though I have so many bands and artists I really dig but I constantly come back to him."

While everyone is very involved in their professional lives outside of the group, the members of the band are pretty active in our community as is the band itself. They've supported various events for Habitat for Humanity, Relay for Life, hurricane relief fundraisers among other charities but as a non-profit themselves, they do multiple events throughout the year raising funds and awareness for military support groups, scholarships for high school seniors, and weight lifting teams. This year is their Fourth Annual 5 Winds to the Future Festival at Whiskey Beach Pub on Saturday, July 2nd with five bands including Unit 5 headliner. The festival is named partly in memory of Gary Gordan a soldier who was Spero's teammate while serving in the 10th Special Forces group in the 80's and died while saving many people. His heroism was portraved in the film Blackhawk Down. Watch for updates on their Facebook page for other events.

The band wouldn't be complete if they didn't mention Jason Chesser who does a little bit of everything for them. He is the band videographer, photographer, helps on sound, helps with breakdown, dances, and sits in occasionally on guitar. Make sure to check out Unit 5 live. 





### I see you just released a music video, "Time is Up for You"?




### I know you are a Central Florida based band, when is your next show in the state?



### **KEY WEST BAR**

The Key West Bar on the corner of The Key west Bar on ....

AlA and Eau Gallie Causeway has been there way before most of us. The building has carried several names during the decades, and there is evidence that it has always housed a place of hospitality. "We found some old bar receipts from the 1940s in the attic when we renovated during the pandemic," laughs Kelly Beckstrom who has owned the business solely for the past 4 years but knows the history quite well. "I have worked here all my life, even under-age in the kitchen, as a server and started bartending with 17 when the regular bartender did not show up." All the while she went to school, attended FIT and got her education. But the hospitality industry became her destiny. Through good and bad times, Kelly enjoys keeping her customers entertained. Staying flexible and a good attitude have kept the bar going, even during the pandemic. The once smoking bar opened up with nonsmoking restaurant rules after the lockdown - and the delicious food specials that they serve these days have become a hit with the regulars.

Kelly is the soul of Key West Bar and her customers appreciate her as much as her staff. For her they are all her family, She organizes turkey bowling on Thanksgiving Eve, cabbage bowling on St. Patrick's Day, Mardi Gras and New Year's Eve parties; she sponsors races, even participated with a group known as Key West Rum Runners, and takes her entire staff bar hopping along A1A with limo and all. Why all the fuss? "I want to be the boss and bartender that I want to have," explains Kelly her generosity.

Born in Platation, FL, Kelly came to Brevard when she was 8 years old. Her parents were not rich developers from South Florida; they were simple folks with regular jobs and Kelly learned early that hard work can get you somewhere. Working in a bar and restaurant was something she liked.

She's known the Key West Bar since it was the Pelican, Fiddlestix, Purple Purpoise, Poor Paul's, Yianni's - did we miss any names? - and at the turn of the century it became The Key West Bar. During all this time Kelly worked there "on and off." "Sometimes I get into it with the owners, and I left," she remembers. After a few stints in other localities like Bennigan's and Dixie Crossroads, "I was always called back." The last owner, Steve, wanted a business partner and Kelly took the opportunity. Then four years ago she became the sole proprietor.

Since then she has remodeled the

place. The bathrooms were in need of renovations and she turned the "urinals" into clean and respectable restrooms. She painted the building, installed new floors, and when the pandemic closed the bars, it was a good time for a real deep "That's cleaning. when we found the old receipts in the attic," she says. "The prices were amazing. Back then they charged 90 cents for a shrimp cocktail."

It is the family atmosphere that makes this place a "5 star dive bar." It might not be a rizzy place but the friendliness and service is first class. Besides the regular bar menu, Key West Bar offers daily lunch specials which are amazingly affordable. Kelly explains: "We make most of our profit through liquor sales, so we can be more generous with our food prices." Indeed, the bar used to have just a small kitchen and was not allowed to serve more than 10% of food. "We had to re-do the kitchen to serve more but the customers wanted more food, and I always listen to our customers." These days Steven and Joey run the kitchen and decide which daily special they serve.

Most of the bartenders have been working here for many years, some for decades. Nobody really ever leaves, and if someone does, you will see them again, even if they just help out here and there. On weekends the Key West Bar has always had live music on their stage, and some bands have been performing here since they started performing. The Key West Bar is a fun spot with great bartenders and friendly customers. "What is important is that women feel save to come here," says Kelly - and she is proud of it. and maybe even become parents ourselves, we realize it's the most stressful job there is. Not only do parents not know what they are doing with their own lives, but they are responsible for other lives now too. Later we may begin to look at others like teachers, bosses, religious leaders, politicians (maybe not that last one anymore) and it always seems like they surely must know how to adult better than we do... turns out they probably don't.

The second thing knowing this can be is freeing. Once you know that everyone is the same, that we are all a bunch of scared idiots, it can really take the pressure off. You don't compare yourself to anyone. There are no rules life, and everyone is on their own journey and timeline. And while what I'm telling you is true—we are all individually figuring it out as we go, it's also true that we are all in it together because we are all the same.

Nobody thinks they are enough.

Nobody thinks they are good enough to deserve happiness. Nobody thinks they are good enough to deserve respect. Nobody thinks they are important enough to the people around them to be treated with love and kindness. Nobody thinks they are enough...and everyone is wrong.



his month's CD review is for the ■ band Honey Miller and their compilation CD, GPS HEAVEN. Songs range from 2010 through 2021.

Honey Miller music has been described as "The Sound of The Space Coast". They are an original Americana, Folk, Pop Rock band from Cocoa Beach Florida. Their influences are many but often Mother Ocean sets the tone. More on that later!

The original Honey Miller band consisted of Dave Miller, Jeff Stanton, Ryan Perez, Curtis Bush, Sam Dejesus, Seth Chipman, and Aren Winebrenner. In 2014 the band began reorganizing after suffering a rock and roll meltdown. In fact, I still haven't recovered from mine!

Dave Miller also delves into abstract paintings, colors, pouring mediums, methods and mixed media. He sent me a sample of his art and I'm quite impressed. I love when an artist sends me bling! This will hang in my man cave music room for sure!

The current lineup is Marvin Parish (guitar, vocals), Barry Canfield (drums, percussion, vocals), Anthony Darmana (percussion, mandolin, vocals), and Julie Klein (bass, vocals). All joining in 2015. Jeff Stanton reappeared in 2020.

Let's get to the music! This is a 13 song album consisting of previous recorded tunes and as of yet, unreleased tunes. As the genre dictates, there is not a lot of flashy stuff going on. I consider this a good thing. This CD oozes with substance and originality! One of the most "original" CDs I have ever reviewed. Thoroughly enjoyable. There is not a bad tune on the album. Some tunes have Pink Floyd like intros. Some have a Santana feel. All while keeping to that Floribean, Space Coast beach living attitude. Simply amazing! 
