# Sonic Slam Tour 2022: Cinderella's Tom Kiefer Band L.A. Guns & Faster Pussycat

Tom Keifer's story begins as the singer-songwriter, guitarist and front man of hard rock heavyweights Cinderella. His signature voice, guitar and bluesy, no-BS arena-shaking songwriting, played an integral role in moving records to the tune of 15 million worldwide. Tom Keifer is enjoying continued success recording and touring with his Kiefer Band, releasing two critically acclaimed solo albums, The Way Life Goes and Rise. The Kiefer Band features Tom Keifer, Savannah Keifer, Tony Higbee, Billy Mercer, Kendra Chantelle, Jarred Pope and Kory Myers. They are fired up to get back on tour with their high energy, leave it all on the stage rock show that combines all the classic, chart topping hits of Cinderella with new faves from

Kiefer's 's solo releases. Eddie Trunk, music historian, radio personality, talk show host, tweeted from a 2019 show: "Simply ridiculous how great Tom Keifer and his band sound right now, New stuff killer too! And thanks for keeping it real and all live. No tracks."

The latest Keifer Band studio album, *Rise*, (Billboard Top 10 Hard Rock Sales), released September 13, 2019 on *Cleopatra Records*, features the rousing, rollicking rock singles, "The Death of Me" and "Hype." Both singles landed in the Billboard Mainstream Rock Top 40. Keifer's deepseated roots shine through to the very core on *Rise*, something that was embedded at the very heart of his music created during the multiplatinum Cinderella days.

L.A. Guns was formed in 1983 and have sold over six million records, including 1988's L.A. Guns and 1990's Cocked And Loaded, both of which were certified Gold. Cocked And Loaded contained the hit single "Ballad of Jayne" that went to #33 on Billboard's Hot 100 and #25 on the Mainstream Rock charts. From the mid-90s to the mid 2000's, L.A. Guns continued to tour and release new music. Following their successful performance at Sirius' HairNation Festival in September 2016, L.A. Guns went into the studio to record the critically acclaimed, The Missing Peace, which was the highest selling release for Frontiers Music in 2017. Their 12th album, The Devil You Know, was released in 2019 to the same critical acclaim. November 2021 brought the release of their latest album, Checkered Past. Since reuniting, Tracii and Phil continue to tour around the world with L.A. Guns, which currently includes Shane Fitzgibbon (drums), Johnny Martin (bass) and Ace Von Johnson (guitar).

Faster Pussycat rose from the depths of the mid-'80s Hollywood rock scene, taking the Sunset Strip by storm with a sound that wasn't glam and wasn't punk, but blistered somewhere in between. With an attitude and swagger all its own, their self-titled debut featured the instant classics "Babylon," "Bathroom Wall," "Cathouse" and "Don't Change That Song," and its follow-up, Wake Me When It's Over, climbed even higher with the radio hit "House Of Pain," "Poison Ivy" and "Where There's A Whip There's A Way." Despite their successes, Faster Pussycat defied the mainstream mold and always followed frontman Taime Downe's underground sensibilities. The Gold and Platinum records are nice, but Taime considers his greatest accomplishment to be longevity. "The only number that really matters to me is the number 35. Three and half decades later, Faster Pussycat are still rocking, and it feels as fresh as it did in 1986." Look no further than their 2021 releases "Nola" and the Johnny Thunders cover "Pirate Love" - Faster Pussycat are as virile and tenacious as ever and Taime, bassist Danny Nordahl, drummer Chad Stewart, and guitarists Sam "Bam" Koltun and Ronnie Simmons wouldn't have it any other way.

This show is brought to the Kinge Center by *Soulshine Events* (Dave Wruble). This is the first time that these bands perform at the King Center's main stage. We know that the 80s Glam Bands have a huge following remembering the now defunct festival series of 80s In The Park. # **Casual Friends**

There are many reasons and motivations for artists to create. Some seek fame and fortune. Others need a way to express themselves. If you're lucky, some find a path that will lead them to both. For the vast majority, one's attempt ends before it ever really got started.

"All I ever wanted to do was original music, it's what I love," explains local singer Katty Pleasant. This may surprise some of the those who remember her of the very popular cover band Katty Shack. She is a part of a new group, Casual Friends, which reunites her with former bandmates and her first love of songwriting.

To know the present, we must first acknowledge the past. Pleasant met bassist Ben Saint Denis and guitarist/ singer Anders Soergel through mutual friend Derek Suomi in Orlando in 2005. "Ben, Nick Benik (drummer and future Casual Friends collaborator) and I were a band since childhood where I was the singer," Soergel recalls. "We gave her a demo without vocals and she loved it and called us". The band, Fall Term, proceeded to play shows until 2009. Their stoppage however did not mean the end of writing and living as best friends to this day. "The crazy part is that we've never stopped making music together in some capacity, so we've been a band basically almost 20 years in a sense," he continues.

While Fall Term did its thing in Florida, drummer Tommy Craig did his seemingly everywhere else including LA. Coming up in the scene as part of the Scooby-Dos, then Skum and most recently he did 6 years with The Pat Travers Band. When that gig ended, he was ready, willing and able to hold down the beat for Casual Friends.

"We had talked about this for years," says Craig. He has a studio/practice space where the quartet write, practice and cohabitate the post pandemic state of the world.

With the lineup complete, the band finds themselves enjoying each other's company; not an easy feat for anybody especially those who have known each other as long as they have. "I had been living in Flagler County and Ben and Anders would come up," Pleasant remembers. "We would back pack and do 7-11 runs at 4am on our way to the beach. Saint Denis adds, "My Slim Jim intake was never that high before or since."

"People have said to me this music sounds like you are having fun," he continues. "We are able to be selfsufficient because we can do everything ourselves in Tommy's practice space." Pleasant and Craig both say that Casual Friends is the best music they have made in their careers.

The music they create is impressive. Take the best of the 80s pop rock ala The Cars and Blondie. Throw in 90s Garbage, all the while a heavy drum backbeat fueling it that a drum machine could never suffice.

The band's first single, 'Personal', really ties it all together. Mixed and mastered by now Denver resident (and former Fall Term drummer Nick Benik), the band sounds familiar but not outdated. Fresh but not naive. The accompanying music video also shows a playfulness the band members with the storyline.

The video opens with the band onstage. Clips of them dressed in powdered wigs show the band enact a Marie Antoinette-esque 'Let Them Eat Cake' plot. Let's just say Saint Denis doesn't fair well. Benik served as the video's editor with Space Coast legend Brendon Paredes directing the clip. "It was a satisfying process to see our imagination come to life before our eyes through the hard work of everyone involved," says Soergel.

With a video and recorded music under their collective belt, Casual Friends are starting to look at their live debut as a band.

"We have intentionally kept things low key up until the video came out," explains Craig. "We would like to set up our own shows in places like Wickham Park," suggests Saint Denis. Pleasant adds, "I've always been a fan of big production. I want people to see a show and have an experience as opposed to just go to a gig."

At press time, the band had finished tracking a new song called 'Hell-95'. "The lyrics are essentially to say that we are okay knowing that in the bigger picture we know nothing," offers Soergel. "So many people go through life trying to convince others that they're something they aren't, because that's what or who they think others want them to be." He concludes; "The entire song, lyrics and all took 5 minutes to write."

# MY REMEDY

The latest rocket blasts off into space and as you watch the vapor trail catch the winds, various songs come to mind: Rocket Man, Space Oddity, and Space Cowboy to name a few. You and your friends are seeing My Remedy play this weekend and are excited as you've heard so many good things about them. So, what do the songs have in common with the band My Remedy? Read on and find out.

My Remedy is a multifaceted rock band covering music from the 70s to current day along with a few originals. This active and engaging band consists of the sister and brother tandem of Kathy (Kat) Rice on drums and vocals and John Lesman on lead guitar and background vocals. They are joined by Kevin Vander Molen on lead vocals, guitars and harmonica and Jim Kelly on bass and background vocals. Playing four to five times a month at a variety of clubs in Central Florida and at various private events keeps the band quite busy. Outside of the band they all are working professionals and busy

with family along with other activities. Let's meet them.

Kevin is retired military originally from Michigan and currently working at Cape Canaveral Space Force Station. He remembers always having an interest in music and one of his earliest childhood memories is that of sitting in the living room of the family's farmhouse listening to the 45 album "Four by the Beatles" over and over on his older sister's portable record player. Although having a desire to play and sing he really didn't pursue these on a much broader scale until later in life. At the age of 43, he began to teach himself to play acoustic guitar as a surprise for his wife. Two years later, seeing his potential for playing and singing, she arranged for him to take voice lessons in which within six months he was singing on stage with his church's praise team! These experiences have led him to be passionate about encouraging and mentoring anyone of any age who wishes to pursue their musical interests. It's never too late! To quote a friend, "You don't have to be great to get started, but you've got to start to be great."

Kat is a meteorologist who is a Florida native from Miami. She and brother John come from a close-knit

family of 5 children. She also served in the military, nine of them as an activeduty Air Force officer. Fun fact is that the accordion was her first instrument as a child mainly because she wanted to play something different than her sisters who were both in piano lessons when they were young; she also tried guitar. She started playing drums in 2010 when her daughter started high school as she found herself with a lot of free time. Kat said, "I thought it would be a good way to avoid the 'empty-nest' syndrome and I found drums captivating." Before they were in the band, her and John used to just get together and jam. Kat also plays in the band WEEP.

John is a biologist and primarily works on projects that include the restoration of natural habitats. His skills include plant and wildlife identification, wetland delineation and natural habitat enhancement plans. John was born in Massachusetts but was raised in Miami, Florida. Like his and Kat's father, he also served in the USAF.

James was born in Ohio and grew up outside the rock'n'roll capital of Cleveland and his love of music started at an early age. He is retired from the military and grew up performing classical music (clarinet and flute) before branching out into Jazz (saxophone) in high school and college. occasional gig or sits in the orchestra pit for a local show, most of his time now is working production sound and lighting for Brevard County middle and high school choir and theater events.

The start of the band came together about 11 years ago initially as a project to play some songs at Kat's brother's 50th birthday party. Kat knew Kevin sang and asked him to join her and put something together for the party. It was a success and led to John joining in which turned into a regular jam. After several months, they played their first gig as a band at a Relav for Life. Kevin explained that the jams were a way to release stress which prompted the name My Remedy. Answering the question... How do you relieve stress? Well, My Remedy is performing music with friends. Although their influences all match up to Beatles, Zeppelin, Van Halen, AC/DC, Boston and most other top classic rock acts, the music they play covers a wide variety of bands. By combining electric and acoustic music in their sets you can expect to hear Seven Mary Three, Tom Petty, The Wallflowers, Blur, Neil Diamond's Sweet Caroline, Stone Temple Pilots, Clash, Billy Idol, Cage the Elephant, and even some Tom T. Hall country (with Kat breaking out the accordion) along with their influences and others. They put their own spin or pick out different covers a lot of times and constantly are searching for new material. Always engaged with the audience, nothing is not considered to be performed. Giving back to the community is a big part of what the band does outside of their normal club schedule. They have performed and provided support for 8-10 years for Back to Nature Wildlife Refuge, St. Mary's School in Rockledge, Publix Marathon and Half Marathon, Toys for Tots, along with various Relay for Life events. When asked about

performing, each had some different thoughts to share. Kevin said, "As an introvert to my core, performing on stage can be surreal at times. I never imagined I would be doing this, and as the front man no less. I absolutely love rocking out with my friends as we interact with the crowd, putting a smile of people's faces," adding, "though it never ceases to amaze me how we can play a song at one venue with little crowd response and then play the same song at another venue and the crowd reacts as if it is the best song ever! You just never know." John told me, "When people start to move and dance with the music it feels great and I really get into it. I can't help but smile and move too. I am always amazed when we are playing a venue to look over and see my sister on drums. How cool is that?" Kat expanded on this some, "When the crowd really gets into it, dancing, singing, etc., I have the best view from the drum risers. People often say to me, 'I always wanted to learn how to play the drums,' and I say, 'THEN DO IT!'" Jim talked about how playing live is the best part of being in a band, "Some of the best and most surprising parts about live shows are that after all these years, I still enjoy it as much as I did when I started playing. I love the interaction with the audience, watching people dance and having fun. I enjoy the fellowship with my band mates and the rush of playing live where anything can happen. Most of all, it's my remedy for the stressor of everyday life."

# Skylar Green

Music can be fickle. You can obsess, I mean really obsess, over a song. Play it everyday. Then you get busy doing other things and lose track of it until it is time to write a story. Pull it back up after not hearing it for a long while. And fall in love with it all over it again. Hypothetically speaking of course... "Dissbelief" by local singer songwriter Skylar Green is that song.

More about that in a bit. The Brevard by way of California musician can be a little impulsive. "I've only been playing live for about a year," she explains, admittingly, a few months prior to the release of this story. Green went all in to play music professionally. All in. "I quit my job to play music full time," she continues. Growing up playing music in church and writing poetry in 6th grade, the songstress has played bar gigs as well as multiple turns as Derrk Gores' Dreamland in EGAD. We didn't punch in any edits. He was perfect to set up and record an acoustic artist. It was very personal and a lot of fun." Green credits her godfather and childhood church worship leader Steve Irwin as her main musical influence. "He taught me that have soul through my voice." English singer/songwriter Ben Howard and Hall of Famer Stevie Nicks also played a big part of Green's musical evolution as well.

At press time, Green is about to release her second solo single 'LLORANDO' (Spanish for crying).



## Rigg's Outpost FISHING REPORT JULY FORECAST

July in Brevard offers the best of all worlds due to calm conditions and a huge abundance of bait. I'm going offshore for our exciting adventure! One mile out the Sebastian Inlet north bound is an extensive patch reef system. Party boat and charter boats just go from reef to reef and drift in 30 to 50 feet of pristine aqua water. What's so cool is that when you hook up, you can see your fish. The mate can watch the rod jerking and know what the species is.


So get this, we supply the rods, the bait and the ice. Every July morning is calm with a light onshore breeze. The ocean is quite reflective so wear some good sunglasses and bring plenty of water. Using a double dropper system, it's a can't miss. Boom over the rail and a mangrove snapper and a triggerfish. Brilliant colorful fish that are unbelievably tasty. Add some jacks, bonita and grouper to the list and it's solid action. Further out are the extensive weed lines that provide shade for the most desired summer fish, the dolphin aka mahi. Trolling the edges of the Sargasso highway watching for the electrifying charge of green and yellow competing to get your baits. Charged up my friends. The crazy leaping nut jobs are everywhere. Sometimes 30 to 50 pounds. So what do I do? Well, book a charter in advance of your trip with Rigg's Outpost in downtown Melbourne. All charters are prepared to fish reefs and or troll. Always a success and the trip of a lifetime.

The beach action will be active in the early and late times of the day. Schools of menhaden and finger mullet will traverse parallel to the coastline. Followed by snook, tarpon and the jack crevalles. Top water plugs cast around the perimeters of the bait could hook you up with these Florida gamefish. FWC rule protect snook during the spawning season. The season opens September 1st. Tarpon must be released in the water and are also heavily protected. Please watch for the "Manatee Zones" and slow down so as not to hurt our precious sea cows.

Rent a shady pontoon or an open console from Rigg's . Sign up a few days in advance. Pretty sure they have plent of pontoons ready to go. I suggest you load up with ice, beverages and live bait for the ultimate trip.

Well my friends come spend July in Melbourne and Rigg's Outpost will assist your every need to achieve a wonderful vacation!
