RARE OF BREED THE RESTORATION TOUR

Born and raised in North Carolina, Rare of Breed went from the streets of Charlotte to the backroads and tobacco fields of Stella, NC. Placed in foster care at age 8, a therapist gave him a notebook and encouraged him to write his thoughts in order to release his feelings in a healthy way. It started with poetry and slowly evolved into lyrics and songs. It wasn't until his teen years that it all turned upside down. He got expelled from High School at 16 for selling prescription medications on campus. He was then sent to Tarheel Challenge Academy, a reformed military school, in Salemburg, NC. After graduating with a GED, he went back to the streets that landed him there. Homeless and eager to make money, his poor decisions eventually landed him in jail at the age of 18. With nowhere to turn while struggling with addiction, self-worth, brokenness and anger, he finally found the hope he needed in a church. He hit his knees and God opened the door. He accepted Jesus, and it transformed his life. This new life of faith continues to shape the music he makes and will forever be the center of his message. Rare of Breed has gained success and great momentum with a musical style he calls GodTwang. He blends Country and Christian music with Hip-Hop production to create a sound that's refreshing and unique. For tickets:

Crystal Gayle

Crystal Gayle is a beloved country music icon whose reign in the music business includes 22 No. 1 country hits, four top twenty pop hits, six albums certified Gold by the RIAA and three certified Platinum, including *We Must Believe in Magic* which was the first album by a female artist in country music history to reach platinum sales. Her list of platinum and gold is matched by her awards and accolades. CMA's "Female Vocalist of the Year" for two consecutive years, Crystal is also a Grammy® Award winner for "Best Female Vocal Performance" thanks to her timeless, international smash hit *Don't It Make My Brown Eyes Blue*. Crystal has three Academy of Country Music Awards statuettes for "Top Female Vocalist" and won four American Music Awards. Not surprisingly, she was named the Most Performed Country Female Artist on radio for the decade of 1975-1985. Perhaps nothing sums up Crystal's career achievements better than being awarded with a star on the fabled Hollywood Walk of Fame in October 2009. Famous for her nearly floor-length hair, Crystal was voted one of the 50 most beautiful people in the world by *People Magazine* and in 2016 the Academy of Country Music honored her with the Clifflie Stone Pioneer Award. Gayle was inducted into the Grand Ole Opry in 2017 by her sister and Opry legend Loretta Lynn.

LITTLE RIVER BAND

The Eagles founding member, the late Glenn Frey, knew what he was saying when he dubbed Little River Band “the best singing band in the world.” Through the ‘70’s and ‘80’s, LRB enjoyed huge chart success with multiplatinum albums and chart topping hits like: “Cool Change,” “The Night Owls,” “Happy Anniversary,” “Reminiscing,” “Lonesome Loser,” “Take It Easy On Me,” “Help Is on Its Way,” “We Two,” “Man On Your Mind,” “The Other Guy,” and “It’s A Long Way There.”

Worldwide albums, CD sales and digital downloads now top 36 million and LRB has set a record for having had Top 10 hits for 6 consecutive years - In fact, they were the very first band to achieve that remarkable status! According to *BMI*, “Reminiscing” has garnered rare status with over 6 million airplays on American radio, and “Lady” is close behind with over 5 million airplays.

Bassist/vocalist Wayne Nelson joined the band in 1980. He worked alongside founding members with some of the most distinctive harmonies and vocal abilities, creating the unique LRB sound. In 1981, Nelson

was recognized by world renowned Beatles producer Sir George Martin whom, while producing ‘*Time Exposure*’, chose Nelson to record lead vocals on two of the band’s biggest hits, “The Night Owls” and “Take It Easy On Me.” Later that same year guitarist extraordinaire Stephen Housden joined LRB bringing a rock element into the band’s sound and helped contribute to their string of Top 10 hits. As band members departed, both Housden and Nelson worked together to bring LRB into the new millennium.

To date, lead singer/bassist Wayne Nelson has contributed his vocal and bass guitar talents on 22 Little River Band Albums/CD’s. LRB continues to perform to sold out audiences, and Stephen Housden continues to write and participate in all things Little River Band.

In 2004 LRB was inducted into the Australian Recording Industry Association Hall of Fame at the 18th Annual *ARIA Music Awards*, and in September 2015 the band was awarded Casino Entertainer of the Year at the G2E Gaming Expo in Las Vegas Nevada.

Turning the page brings us to the current lineup of Little River Band...

Keyboardist and vocalist **Chris Marion** is a Dove Award winning producer. Chris is the creator of all the orchestral arrangements and charts on *The Big Box* and *BLACK TIE*. It is amazing to watch him play, sing, and conduct from his riser!

Singing Drummer **Ryan Ricks** has locked down the rhythm section, and rounds out the vocals with his incredible range. Great singing drummers are rare...and LRB is lucky to have Ryan as part of that all-important vocal blend.

Nashville Guitarist **Colin Whinery** plays lead guitar, and shares lead vocal duties with Wayne. He continues to deliver a unique voice and a fresh outlook to the lead section.

Nashville Singer-Songwriter and Guitarist **Bruce Wallace** plays rhythm guitar and adds a new layer to the vocal harmonies. The addition of Bruce to the line-up has added to the energy of the already highly energized LRB.

Early 2014 saw the release of Little River Band’s, ‘*Cuts Like a Diamond*,’ on *Frontiers Records*. “What If You’re Wrong,” went to #1 and stayed there for 3 weeks says Jim Shoe of *CLASSX Radio*. In November of 2016, LRB released, ‘*The Hits...Revisited*,’ on *World Records*. This CD consists of 9 re-recorded hits along with 2 new songs. May of 2017 brought the release of ‘*The Big Box*’ - a box set consisting of 6 discs’s featuring a DVD with live footage from their 40th Anniversary Tour. In November of 2020, during the Pandemic, and in partnership with *TIME LIFE*, the orchestral accompanied ear candy ‘*BLACK TIE*,’ was released to rave reviews. In 2024, Little River Band released their new album ‘*Window To The World*.’ They are currently writing songs for the next album.

2025 rolled the band into their 50th Anniversary with a total 92 shows with their “HAPPY ANNIVERSARY TOUR.” During that tour they also did 23 co-bill shows with **Three Dog**

Axolotl Peso

Part 1

One of the most endangered amphibians in the world is the elusive, always smiling amphibious creatures - the axolotl. On The Keyboard

JIM PACELT

of Mondo Tikis and Love Valley


Jim Pacelt strolls into the yard of the Balinese-inspired venue, among the lavish, bamboo-filled space, and steps up into the thatch-covered hut, over to his keyboard, as the band's tie-dye tapestry and shirts fill the Balibar stage. The audience steps closer, barefoot, and dances as the band's notes fill the air. Mondo Tikis is a psychedelic rock band specializing in tunes from the 60s and 70s and known for their Grateful Dead tributes. It consists of Jim Pacelt on keys and vocals, Jon Allen Woodward on vocals and drums, Jeff Meyer on bass, and Corbin Potts on guitar. Jim appreciates that his band isn't afraid to take the music in unexpected directions. He says, "The real gravy is in the jam, the musical interactions, and conversation. Music should be fun, engaging, and communal." Mondo Tikis started in Cocoa Beach in 2010 with Al Hugley (RIP) and Jim. Jon Allen Woodward was brought in later on drums. Former members include Mike Brown, Jacob Cirillo, Phil Schwartz, and Jared Forst.

Jim is also a key member (pun intended) of Love Valley, tapping out tunes with this very talented band. Love Valley is a Southern Rock band that draws on classic rock, blues, and country. The band includes Vince Cranford on guitar, harmonica, and vocals; Jeremy Novick on percussion; Corey Yentz on bass and guitar; and Mr. Jim Pacelt caressing the keyboard.

Jim recalls his earliest musical memory: at age eight, on the stairs of a Polk Brothers furniture store in Chicago. The store was filled with multiple radios, all tuned into the same station, when the Moody Blues' "Nights in White Satin" came on, and the bass rip shook his whole body. "That was it for me," states Jim. "I thought, that's cool! And I knew at that moment, I was in! I wanted to play the bass."

While in high school, Jim recalls that everybody wanted to be a guitarist or a drummer, and, as a bass player, he thought, "Yeah, this was the right move," because he could play in multiple bands wherever needed. To promote his bands, Jim would use a gorilla marketing technique, stuffing flyers into the Chicago Reader (a monthly newspaper distributed freely at various Chicago locations).

Jim has played with Family Problem, a Chicago-based band, from 1985 to the present day, as they still get together annually to play. This tight-knit group plays all original music. They've written their songs collaboratively and built the music together, and when they reunite, they don't miss a beat. Also, when back in Chicago, if the opportunity arises,

Attending our first concert is a memory we don't forget, and Jim's was certainly one for the books. His first concert was the Black Sabbath "Never Say Die!" tour, 1978, Chicago, which featured Van Halen, on tour for their debut album, *Black Sabbath*, still with Ozzy Osbourne. Jim says, "Growing up in Chicago was the best; all the bands played Chicago."

In the early 80s, Jim was drawn to classic rock, and when that got stale, he moved on to punk rock. His favorite being Ian Dury and the Blockheads. He enjoyed James Brown, Parliament/Funkadelic, New York Dolls, and Beastie Boys before discovering the Grateful Dead. Once he got on that bus, it was a long, strange trip. Jim attended 67 Dead shows and 10 Jerry Garcia Band shows throughout the 80s and 90s. Jim even had the opportunity to shake Jerry's hand. He knocked on the bus door, called out Jerry's name, the door opened, and there was Jerry, hand outstretched and shaking Jim's hand.

Transitioning over to play the keyboard, Jim, a natural musician and self-taught, saw a need. There were plenty of bass players, but not many keyboardists. The keyboard brings an extra level of sound to the band. Jim has a unique, animated style that gets everyone's attention. Playing the

keyboard has opened up opportunities.

One of Jim's most memorable music experiences includes a time he refers to as his "time runnin' with a red-neck crowd." He opened for Marty Stuart, the Grammy-winning country music Hall of Fame singer, in front of an audience of about 15,000 people while he was a part of the Shane Wooten Band.

Jim also played in the Michael Allman Band (Gregg Allman's son) and recalls a night when Michael invited the entire audience onstage to dance. The venue wasn't thrilled, and the following night, a waiver was presented for signatures before their next show, ensuring this stunt wouldn't happen again. Always a wild ride.

Cocoa Beach's very own Legend Of The Seagullmen was another band Jim previously ran with; bandmates included Brent Hinds (RIP), with whom he made 3D movies in Hollywood and headlined the first 3D music festival there. Local hero Jewop Steve was the original drummer, with Dr. Dave Dryer on guitar, and Dave Graves on bass. "Hollywood was not in the cards for me," Jim said.

When asked if Jim could collaborate with any musician, living or dead, he responded, "Well, that's a tough question. Locally, I collaborate with my friends, to collaborate with my heroes, well, I don't know if I could keep up with the people I love, that's why they're my heroes. I'd give it a go, though."

Jim says the hardest part of his job is waiting all week for the weekend. The best part of the job is making people happy and watching people have fun with the music.

With Easter approaching, Jim spilled the beans (not the jelly ones), sharing that he takes his eggs over easy, he prefers chicks to bunnies... because "chicks are the best," and peeps are alright by him.





Mildred Dell Bracknell always went by her middle name of Dell. Her family were the founders of a small post World War II village that was destined to fill over spill of London's population. Located about twenty five miles west of London it has become a sprawling city with high tech services and a healthy economy.

Hayes. His character was Lincoln Vail who was a law enforcement officer that patrolled the Glades in the aforementioned airboat. As dad and my brother were Gladesmen, the shows producers hired them as consultants and stuntmen in the series. Uncle Ron was a regular fixture at our home and the parties that seemed to happen often.

Soon enough mom became pregnant with my younger sister. The little house on 2nd street was sold and we moved to a larger home directly across from the Tamiami canal where us kids learned to swim. Soon after the move, Starr was born. Being the little hellion that I was, I didn't like that at all! I was no longer the priority, dang it! I guess I revolted a lot because spankings were frequent, lol!

Mom and dad grew a massive vegetable garden in the empty lot across the road and I had to pull a lot of weeds in the hot summer heat. Perhaps that's why I'm becoming a fan of gardening these days, even though pulling weeds is still an onus to bear, who knows.

Needless to say I survived the spankings and grew up to write these memoirs. Next month will be a bit more in detail about mom and some other memories. Thanks for reading and remember...That's my Flori-Duh!

Movie Review

Hamnet

Drama/History- 2h5m Rated PG-13

Based on: Hamnet (2020) by Maggie O'farrell
 Screenplay by Maggie O'farrell and Chloe' Zhao
 Director: Chloe' Zhao
 Starring: Jessie Buckley as Agnes Shakespeare; Paul Mes-
 cal as William Shakespeare; Emily Watson as Mary Shake-
 speare; Jacobi Jupe as Hamnet Shakespeare; Noah Jupe
 as Hamlet; Joe Alwyn as Bartholomew Hathaway

Hamnet (the novel and film) is a work of Historical fic-
 tion, which I was happy about. My English literature
 is average at best. The film incorporates a few known facts
 about Shakespeare's family but inventing most of the emo-
 tional story. Historically, William (18) married Anne Ha-
 thaway(26); she was referred to as Agnes in the novel and
 the movie. (Because Anne's father named her in his will as
 "Agnes"). They wed in 1582, she was already pregnant with
 their first child Susanna. In 1585 they had twins, Hamnet
 and Judith. Hamnet died in 1596 at the age of 11. Speculat-
 ing the potential link between Hamnet's death and Shake-
 speare's play Hamlet. It was written about 4 years after his
 son's death. "Hamnet" and "Hamlet" were considered the
 same name in Elizabethan England. Personal details, like
 the cause of death of his son (speculated as plague), family
 dynamics, and specific events are fictionalized interpreta-
 tions of Maggie O'farrell's novel and the screenplay written
 by Maggie and Chloe'.

I assumed the movie was going to primarily focus on
 William, although he was in London most of the time work-
 ing away from his family, but most of the attention was fo-
 cused on Agnes, and the love story between her and Wil-
 liam and their children. Sadly and historically accurate. In
 Stratford in the 1560's on average sixty-three children were
 baptized and forty-three buried. Mothers were taught to to
 not get too attached to their children. In the movie Agnes and
 Will were very loving and hands on with their children. A
 creative liberty I'm glad they took or the movie would have
 not have made any sense.

Even though this is mostly a fictional movie, I think
 people assume he wrote "Hamlet" for his son. English Lit-
 erature expert or not. This shouldn't be a spoiler because it
 was in the trailer for the film. Agnes goes to see the play;
 not knowing what it was going to be, she pushes her way
 through the crowd to get to the stage. As she leans on the
 stage trying to grasp what she's seeing. And she realizes
 what her husband has written, brace yourself for the stinging
 in your eyes that you know will lead to tears. (Luckily, I had
 a napkin!) She reaches out to the dying "Hamlet" on stage,
 her eyes filled with ecstatic tears. She is overwhelmed at the
 art Will created out of their tragedy. You can see on her face
 that she may heal. The scene was breathtaking.

I liked the pace of the movie. I've had people tell me
 it had slow periods, it's not an action movie! It was a visu-
 ally beautiful film. The performances were staggering. But,
 Buckley (as Agnes) had the most outstanding performance
 in her career. She is going to be tough to beat at the award
 shows this year. I left the theater so happy that interesting,
 beautiful story telling is alive and well. I highly recommend
 this movie. It was a nice surprise.

 the official launch of a "Time Bank"
 Initiative, where individuals between
 ages 50 and 75 can contribute volun-
 teer time to assist seniors and later use
 that banked time for themselves. The
 BSO Senior Walk & Show is the be-
 ginning of a movement to recognize,
 support, and empower our seniors.




