



THE FABULOUS THUNDERBIRDS

The Fabulous Thunderbirds are an American blues band formed in 1974. Singer Kim Wilson is the only constant member through the band's entire history. The group just returned from a tour in the United Kingdom. Their first live show back in the US is at the Vero Beach Blues Festival as headliner on Saturday night.

After performing for several years in the Austin, Texas, blues scene, the band won a recording contract with Takoma/Chrysalis Records and later signed with Epic Records. In 2011, they signed with Severn Records. Their first two albums were released in 1979 and 1980, with Kim Wilson's lead vocals and harmonica, Jimmie Vaughan as lead guitarist, and Keith Ferguson on bass guitar. Mike Buck was on drums for the first album but left the band and was replaced by Fran Christina on the second. Both albums are now regarded as significant blues recordings.

The Thunderbirds' blues style mixed Texas blues with the harmonica-laced swamp blues sounds of Slim

Harpo and Lazy Lester, both of whom the Thunderbirds covered. The band's third album, Butt-Rockin', released in 1981, took the band closer to old rhythm and blues and added additional musicians playing piano and brass. Throughout the years the Fabulous Thunderbirds had become favorites of fellow musicians, opening shows for the likes of the Rolling Stones and Eric Clapton. They created classic albums like T-Bird Rhythm (1982) and Tuff Enuff (1986). Tuff Enuff went platinum, selling more than one million copies. Wilson has been nominated for Grammy Awards six times and for Blues Music Awards more than 20 times.

After 14 albums, several singles and compilation albums, the Fabulous Thunderbirds have released *Struck Down* in 2024. "I think *Struck Down* is my best album with The Fabulous Thunderbirds... by far." says Kim Wilson, the band's leader, main songwriter, vocalist, and harmonica player. Guest Musicians include: Bonnie Raitt, Billy Gibbons (ZZ Top), Mick Fleetwood (Fleetwood Mac), Taj Mahal, Elvin Bishop, Keb' Mo', and Terrance Simien.

The Fabulous Thunderbirds' current line-up are Kim Wilson, the heart and soul of this band, on lead vocals, harmonica, Johnny Moelleron guitar, Bob Welsh on piano and guitar, Rudy Albinon drums, Steve Kirsty on bass.

SHEMEKIA COPELAND

ward-winning blues, soul and Americana singer Shemekia Copeland possesses one of the most instantly recognizable and deeply soulful roots music voices of our time. She is beloved worldwide for the fearlessness, honesty and humor of her revelatory music, as well as for delivering each song she performs with unmatched passion. Copeland, winner of the 2021 Blues Music Award for B.B. King Entertainer Of The Year, connects with her audience on an intensely personal level, taking them with her on what The Wall Street Journal calls "a consequential ride" of "bold and timely blues."

Copeland is used to the spotlight. Born and raised in Harlem, New York in 1979, she first stepped on stage with her famous father at New York's Cotton Club when she was eight. As soon as Copeland released her *Alligator Records* debut *Turn The Heat Up* in 1998 at age 18, she instantly became a blues and R&B force to be reckoned with. On Copeland's new album, *Blame It On Eve*, the songs all hit hard, with jaw-dropping performances that instantly take hold and command repeated listening. "Copeland is the greatest female blues vocalist working today.

Country Artist & Rancher

ELI MOSLEY

When Elisha "Eli" Mosley isn't mending fences or mowing pastures at the 3,000-acre ranch he manages in Polk County, he's most likely traveling to Nashville for a country music project, or touring across the U.S. with his band. This month he will be performing at the 58th Grant Seafood Festival.

Ever since he saw Tracy Byrd on stage at six years old, Eli Mosley knew he would be a country music artist. To prepare, he learned to play the guitar, graduated from Southeastern University with a degree in music business and spent 6 years in the US Marine Corps. Now, at the age of 34, Eli has recorded and produced three albums in Nashville through Ocean Way Studio, Studio West, and Sound Emporium. He is a verified artist on Spotify and one of his singles, "Soldier's Wife," has amassed over 200,000 streams. His most recent single, "Doin' Alright," has peaked at number 77 on the national Music Row chart.

Eli typically travels to Nashville for one to two weeks every month. While he's there, he participates in writing and recording sessions, networking events, meetings with management and more. "I basically pack a month's worth of work into one week," Eli remarked.

Although Eli has considered relocating to Nashville, he's discovered that living in Florida allows him to establish a healthy work-life balance. Eli explained, "Moving to Nashville would be like moving into the office. There's always somewhere you should be or something you should be doing to advance your career. I've come to realize the importance of keeping work and life separate."

Living in Florida also makes it possible for Eli to serve as the foreman of a local cattle ranch. In this position, Eli oversees all of the ranch's operations, from maintaining equipment to ensuring the cows are properly fed. Eli got into ranch work in 2020 when the pandemic forced the music industry to be put on pause.

Since then, it has proven to be a source of inspiration for his creative process. "When you're on the ranch working on a tractor all day, you get a lot of time to think. I've been able to come up with numerous song ideas this way," said Eli. When it comes to songwriting, Eli has collaborated with individuals who have written hit singles for artists such as Garth Brooks, Reba McEntire, and Rascal Flatts. "I always make sure that I'm the least accomplished person in



the room," said Eli. "That's the key as an independent artist. You have to surround yourself with the right team."

Throughout his career, Eli has opened for Tracy Lawrence, Joe Nichols, Tyler Farr, Maren Morris, and many others. In 2020, Eli even opened for his first country music inspiration, Tracy Byrd, at the RP Funding Center in Lakeland, Florida.

His largest audience was in Dallas, Texas, during a show where he played to a crowd of 45,000. In 2017, Eli performed a few acts before Miranda Lambert for an audience of 8,000. He counted this as his first "big" show.




Space Coast State Fair

20 Years Of Sandbar in Cocoa Beach

Living The American Dream

This month, February 2025, Andrew Bunin is looking back on 20 years of Sandbar business. "I'm living the American Dream," he says with a big smile. He's not the only one who has been having a great time, his customers have been enjoying 20 years of beach and party life right along with him. Brevard Live Magazine met with Drew and his GM Nick Strickling to talk about the anniversary year.

It was November 15th, 2005, that Drew and his partner Mark Phelps got the keys to the former Castaways, a small dive bar on the beach from 1958. "We didn't have any customers right away," remembers Drew. "But we were determined to make it work." They started out small, worked long days and nights, they still do, and that's how the Sandbar became the "The Home of the Fish Taco" and a customer favorite for locals and tourists alike. Their slogan is "Get rescued from ordinary food" - and they mean it. The menu is extensive and includes all your favorite tacos, burritos, pizza, burgers, wings, salads, and it all has the extra kick. The drinks are just as unusual as the food. "We don't run from hurricanes, we drink them" is another motto, and these hurricanes come in 5 categories along with the ultimate mother of all hurricanes with white rum, spiced rum, coconut rum, dark rum, triple sec, and a 151 floater. You can keep the glass, and might add a t-shirt, hot sauces, or a koozie.

Finding good people and keeping them around has been one of Drew's secrets to success. Sometimes they found him. Nick Strickling showed up one day 18 years ago, "mainly to help a few friends who worked at the Sand-

bar," he says. He came back the next day, then the following day. He worked as bouncer, bar back, bartender, manager - now he's the General Manager and an owner of the Cocoa Beach Fish Camp, that Drew and Nick opened in 2021. Seven years ago, Drew convinced his brother Jason to relocate from New York to Cocoa Beach to open up Flavour, the restaurant in the heart of Cocoa Beach. Last year Drew and former Sandbar manager Aiden Booska opened a second location in Satellite Beach. Drew has been an inspiration to his co-workers and has made an impact to the local hospitality business. Nick laughs: "We always ask ourselves - would would Drew do?"

What Drew knows best is how to have a good time. The Sandbar has become famous for its outrageous parties and events. Everything goes - from the "Pimp & Ho" costume contest, to bikini contests, to pizza, wings or taco eating contests. "We will celebrate our 20th anniversary all year long," says Drew. "We want to feature a lot of bands and parties that have become legendary."

February 2025 starts with the iconic "King of the Couch" Superbowl party on February 9th. Anyone can register for a raffle, and the winner, who will be drawn one hour before the game, will have a VIP seat on the couch with his friends and get 50 wings, a large pizza, a case of beer, and at the end the winner can take the couch home.

Saturday, Feb 15th, is the official party with live bands and half priced hurricanes. On Thursday, 20th, the Sandbar holds a pizza eating contest along with a karaoke contest, winner gets \$200. The following Saturday, Feb 22nd, it's a Toga Party. For March 22nd Drew plans a Mini-Rockstock with 5 bands on 2 stages. Live Music has always been a big part of the Sandbar. Some pretty popular bands like Hot Pink, Vintage, Red Tide started out playing here. If you've been here, you know the vibe. If not, find out why the Sandbar is more than another beach bar. It's a life style. "We had 49 hurricanes," says Drew, "and we were open during every one of them."

The Nighthawks

The original Nighthawks lineup solidified in mid-1974. Bringing together frontmen Mark Wenner and the young Jimmy Thackery with a veteran rhythm section, Jan Zukowski on bass and Pete Ragusa on drums, the quartet ruled the highways and honky-tonks until Jimmy's departure in 1986 to pursue a solo career. The band opened many doors and forged many touring routes for their contemporaries, including the Fabulous Thunderbirds, Stevie Ray Vaughan and Robert Cray, and played with as many Blues and Rockabilly legends as they could. They opened show after show for Muddy Waters, James Cotton and Carl Perkins, and backed up and recorded with John Hammond and Pinetop Perkins.

The first years after Jimmy's departure were a bit under the radar. Mark, Jan and Pete soldiered on, taking on such roles as Elvin Bishop's East Coast band (from Halifax, Nova Scotia, to Key West) and becoming the backing band of choice for the Rosebud Agency's showcase tours with John Lee Hooker, Elvin Bishop, John Hammond and Pinetop Perkins. After a series of guitarists of the month that included Warren Haynes and Stuart Smith, a collaboration with Wet Willie frontman Jimmy Hall led to several years with a solid quintet that also included guitarist Jimmy Nalls (Sea Level, D.C. Dog). That version of the band never released any recordings.

After more than 5 decades, founder, lead singer and harpmaster Mark Wenner is still at the helm, while drummer Mark Stutso, guitarist Dan Hovey and bassist Paul Pisciotta all share vocals and songwriting, making this lineup one of the strongest ever. Decades of gigs and countless rabid fans have earned them the name "The Best Bar Band In The World." More than a bar band or blues band, this is a band that played with Carl Perkins in addition to Muddy Waters.






